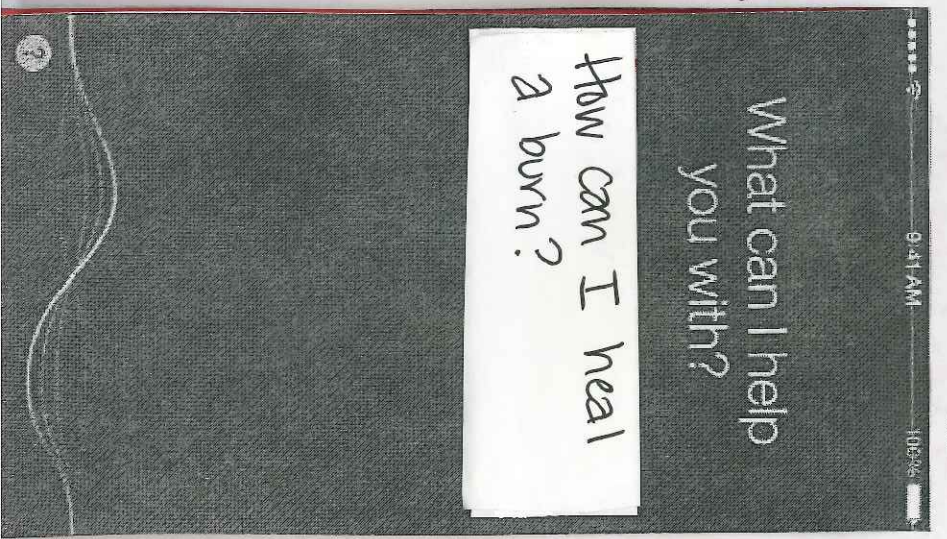
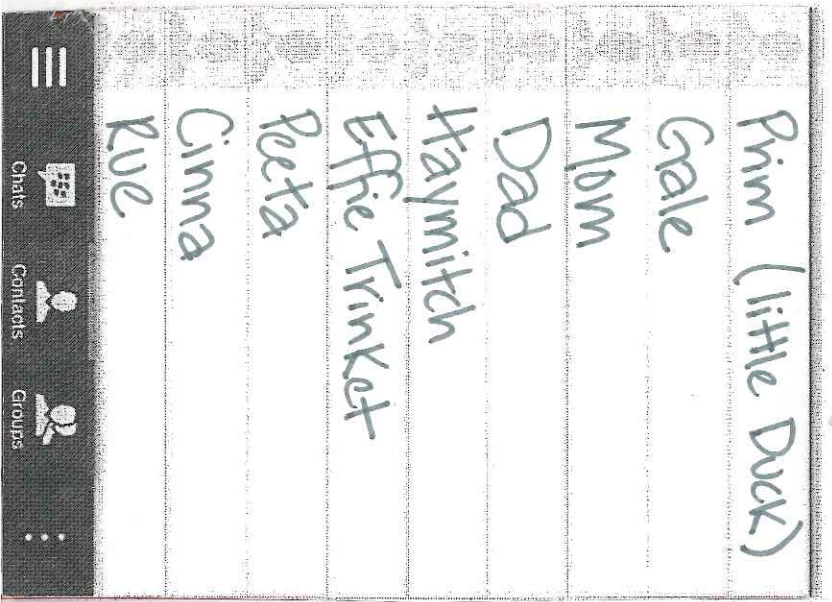
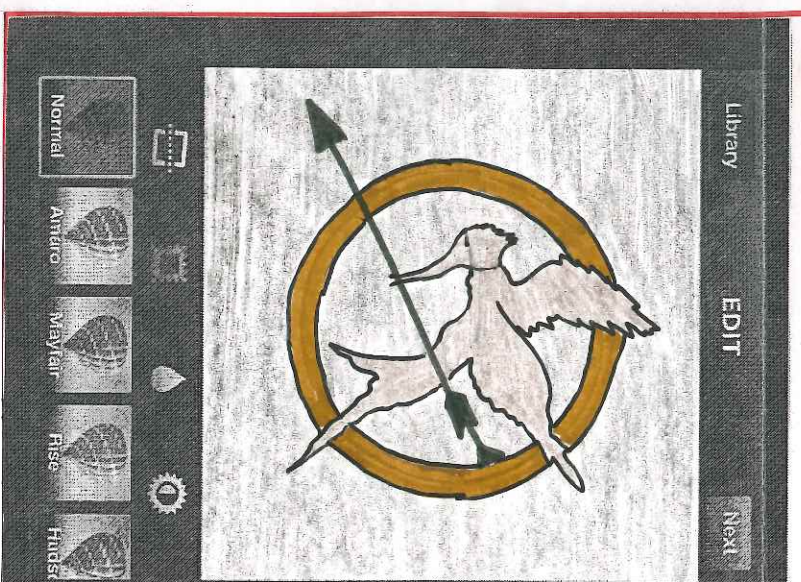
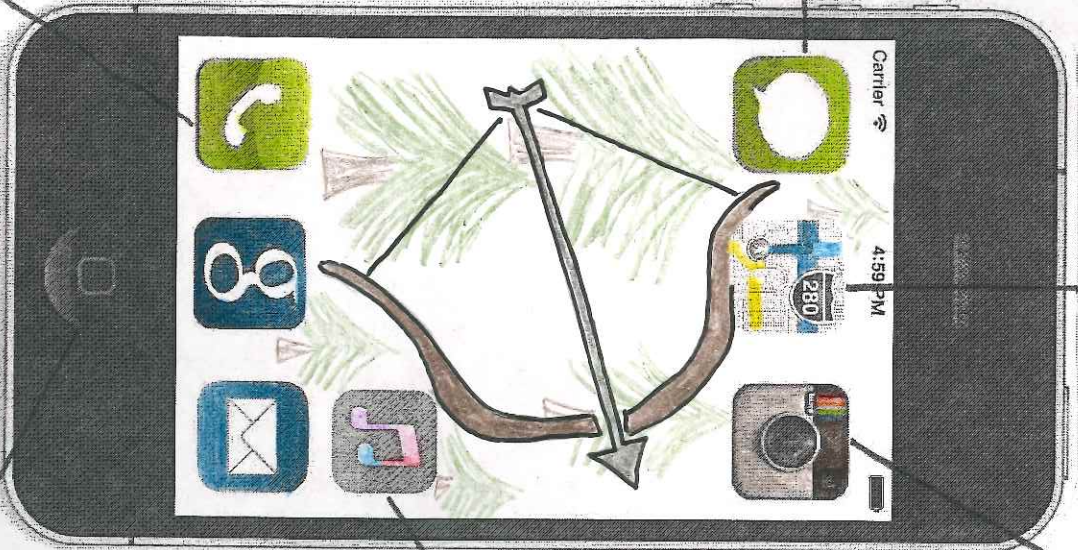
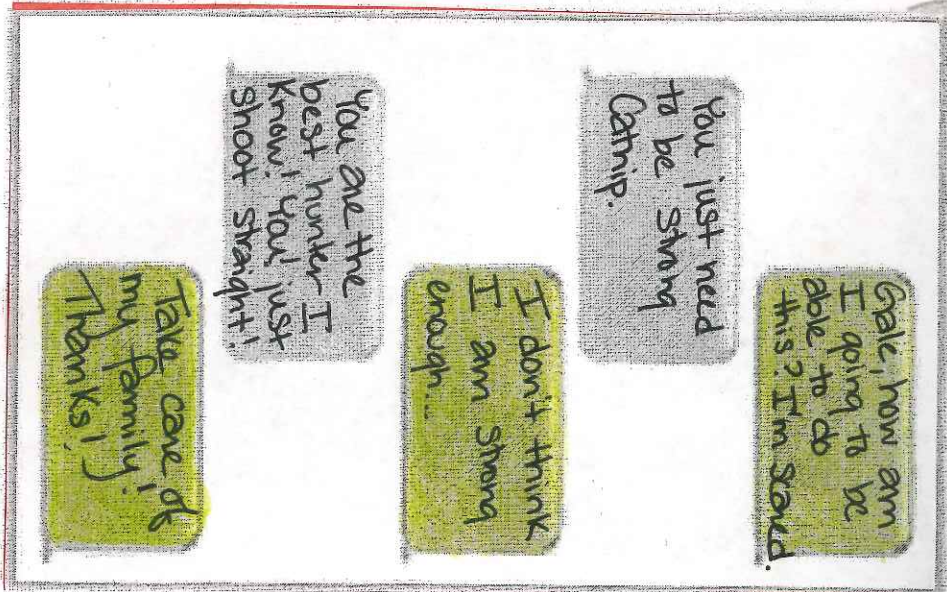


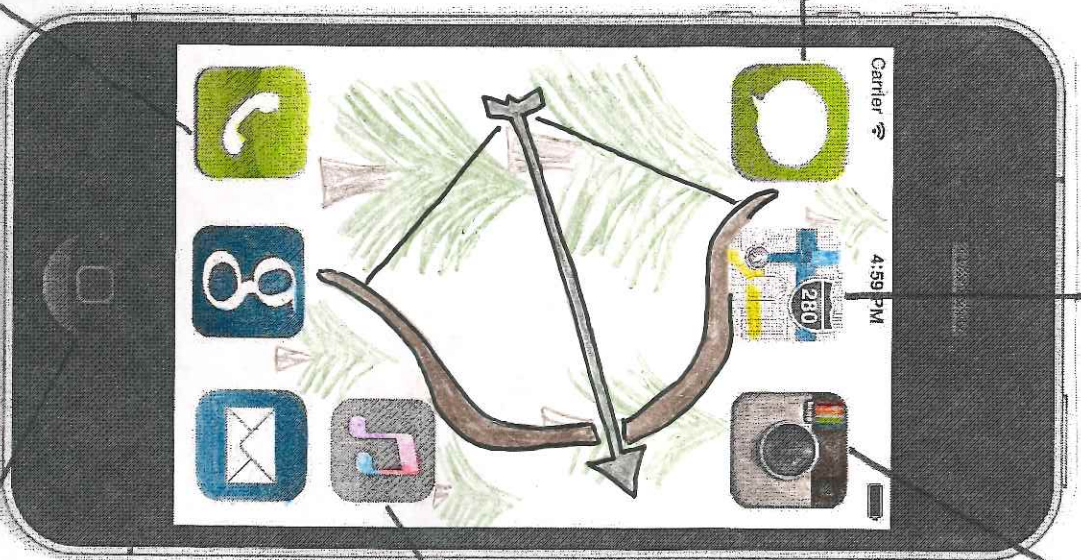
THE HUNGER GAMES
